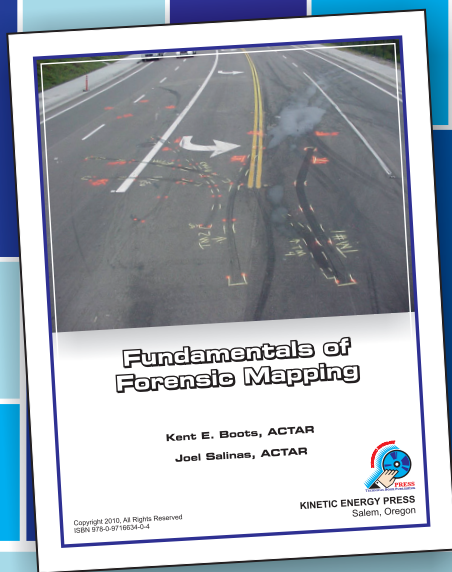


Fundamentals of Forensic Mapping
